The symposium will cover a variety of topics relevant for new science of lipids including:

- health and nutritional aspects of lipids
- pharmaceutical aspects of lipids
- lipids in personalised nutrition
- lipids in skin care
- lipids in aquaculture and pet nutrition
- novel lipids and fatty acids
- lipid oxidation and antioxidants
- novel processing and technology
- advanced lipid analysis and food safety

We emphasise that the program is open for all kinds of lipids in all sessions.

The symposium is an important meeting place for scientists, engineers, sales and marketing personnel and all others working within academia, health care and industry. The event is a unique possibility to exchange science and technology issues related to lipids, fats, and oils.

# Getting to Turku

The city has an airport, harbour, bus station and two railway stations (Turku and Kupittaa).

#### By plane to Turku:

You can fly directly to Turku from Stockholm, Riga and Gdansk (SAS, Air Baltic, WizzAir).

#### By plane to Helsinki:

Helsinki airport is well connected by several airlines (Finnair, SAS, Norwegian and others).



Reach Turku from Helsinki airport:

<u>Train</u>: from Helsinki airport – Pasila (change) – **Kupittaa** (Turku). Upon booking, be aware that destination is Kupittaa (Turku), not Turku. Approx 2.5 hours. From station to venue: 2.4 km.

Bus: Helsinki Airport (Vantaa) - Turku (Turku). Approx 2.5 hours. From station to venue: 1.7 km.

**By boat from Stockholm:** Two ferry companies operate between Turku and Stockholm: <u>Viking line</u> and <u>Tallink Silja line</u>. Distance from harbour to Conference venue: 2.4 km.

**About taxis:** For <u>taxi service</u> we recommend companies Taxidata and Menevä. Especially with other service providers, ask for price beforehand!
