It is a pleasure to invite you to the 8th Nordic Lipidforum Academy, a comprehensive course in Lipid Science and Technology for people who are generally interested in lipids. The Academy is well adapted for PhD students and postdocs, but also very relevant for employees dedicated in the fat and oil industry or R&D institutes. The Academy is organised prior to the 33rd Nordic Lipidforum Symposium 2026.

Course content covers topics such as (topics are tentative and might change):

- BASIC LIPID CHEMISTRY
- ADVANCED LIPID ANALYSIS
- LIPIDS IN NUTRITION
- LIPIDS IN FOODS
- LIPID OXIDATION AND ANTIOXIDANTS
- PROCESSING OF LIPIDS
- CURRENT FRONTLINES IN LIPID RESEARCH

Before the Academy the participants are challenged to write a motivation letter. A small project group work on relevant topics will also be carried out. All groups will have to present their work during the Academy. After the Academy, the participants should pass an examination and write a self-reflection report of what they have learned during the course and how they will use the knowledge in the future. All tasks that must be completed to earn course credits.
